



Sustainability and Social Action, Indonesia Study Tour

Be part of a once-in-a-lifetime Humanities and Social Science opportunity in Indonesia!

This study tour enables pre-service teachers to undertake educational experiences and social action for a shanty dwelling, underclass, community who lack access to education, employment, medicare facilities, or welfare.

Workplace experiences take place in a, who have been abandoned by families, unable to care for them.

Participants will engage in a range of social action initiatives in diverse range of settings in the community, including an unfunded kindergarten, NGO schools for shanty children, a local state-funded school, an Islamic school, and an orphanage for children with disabilities.

In previous tours, students have:

- assessed how to best support those in need and;
- have refurbished dilapidated buildings for educational purposes and;
- provided a water supply.

Students will be able to attract 15 credit points towards their degree with study tour unit HSS4280 (Civics and Citizenship, Global Education and Integration.). Only those following the HSS Specialisation can apply.
