Lotus showcases the creative works of **Robyn BERNADT**, exploring advertising, consumerism and the realities of our vanishing planet through recycled materials, design and formal artmaking. The giclee prints and floor installation, featuring over one thousand origami lotus blooms folded from advertising junk mail, are inspired by the Buddhist proverb, *“the lotus flower blooms most beautifully from the deepest and thickest mud.”* Both highly topical and richly poetic, **Lotus** encourages meditation upon the environmental impact of consumerism while presenting beauty emerging from refuse.
