



NCP Engineering Study Tour to Japan

Apply for a once in a lifetime experience in Japan!

This two week program is designed for undergraduate engineering/technology students.

Week One will include visits to cultural, industrial, and educational sites.

Week two will involve project work in the engineering labs of Tokyo City University (TCU) in collaboration with Japanese academics and students.

The successful completion of the program will provide partial credit (equivalent to two weeks of practicum hours) towards the Engineering Practicum unit: ENS5111 or Technology Practicum unit: ENS3173. Only students who have not yet completed these units are eligible to apply.

There are fifteen places on this study tour. The fifteen selected participants, who must be Australian Citizens, will receive \$3000 grants under the Australian Government's New Colombo Plan.
