Students may get 15 credit points through unit HST3505 International Study Project, but must have completed 180 credit points in order to be eligible.

This project is supported by the Australian Government's New Colombo Plan. To be eligible, you must be an Australian citizen and enrolled in an undergraduate course. There are 9 places available and students will receive \$3,000 to assist with program costs.
