Access personalised counselling and psychotherapy services from our Master of Counselling & Psychotherapy students, guided by specialist Couple and Family Therapy practitioners.

We are also partnered with ECU Psychological Services for holistic care.

We welcome and support people from all walks of life, including Indigenous Peoples, the LGBTIQ+ community, and migrants.

The ECU Counselling Service offers affordable counselling to ensure the service is accessible to all. Fees range from \$10 for casual workers, students and unemployed, \$20 for part-time workers and \$30 for full-time workers.
