Frequently Asked Questions

The School of Nursing and Midwifery are currently undergoing our regular unit review and accreditation process which will be finalised later than normal. This will affect the standard enrolment dates for undergraduate students.

1. When will I be able to enrol?

All students will be able to enrol on the same day to have the same opportunity to select their preferred classes for 2024. All students will be notified when the timetable has opened.

2. Why is there a delay in the timetable being opened?

The delay in the timetable opening is due to the timing of the review of the new units. This is unfortunately not able to be expediated.

3. How will I be notified when the timetable is open for enrolment?

All students will receive an email to their ECU student email account as well as their personal email address (if we have this on your student record).

4. Will this affect my progression?

No, there will not be any impact on your progression.

5. I am currently still enrolled in a prac unit, will this affect my current enrolment?

No, your enrolment will remain as you have enrolled, there will be no impact on 2023 enrolments, even for PR8 students where teaching periods extend into 2024.

6. When can I request an updated course planner from the Student Hub?

After the semester 2, 2023 official results have been published.
